Day 1: Barrydale

Barrydale is a village located on the border of the Overberg and Klein Karoo regions of the Western Cape Province in South Africa. Named after James Barry, it is situated at the northern end of the Tradouw's pass which winds its way through the mountains to Swellendam. Visit the famous <u>Country Pumpkin</u> (optional extra - on own account) for a quick stop along the way.

Day 1: Oudtshoorn

Oudtshoorn, the "ostrich capital of the world", is a town in the Western Cape province of South Africa, located to the south of the Outeniqua Mountains. With approximately 60,000 inhabitants, it is the largest town in the Little Karoo region. The town's economy is primarily reliant on the ostrich farming and tourism industries.

Day 2: Cango Caves

29km from Oudtshoorn, at the head of the picturesque Cango Valley, lie the spectacular underground wonder of the Klein Karoo - the Cango Caves. Situated in a limestone ridge parallel to the well-known Swartberg Mountains, you will find the finest dripstone caverns, with their vast halls and towering formations. <u>Cango Caves</u> is the only show cave in Africa which offers a choice of Heritage (easy) or Adventure Tours.

Day 2: Safari Ostrich Farm

On our guided tour you will learn & see all aspects of ostrich farming & ostriches! Our professional guide will show you all stages from incubation to adulthood. <u>Safari Ostrich Farm</u> also is home to the beautiful & rare White Ostrich. On your tour you will also see the second biggest bird in the world after the ostrich, the Emu.



Day 2: Cango Wildlife Ranch

Our facility has been in existence for 30 years and currently comprises of over 90 different species of animals and 100 full-time staff. <u>Cango Wildlife Ranch</u> provides guided tours which are fundamental in our education programs, giving each species a voice, and enlightening the public on animal and environmental issues.

Day 2: Knysna

Knysna (probably from a Khoikhoi word meaning "ferns") is a town with over 51,000 inhabitants in the Western Cape Province of South Africa and is part of the Garden Route. It lies 34 degrees south of the equator, and is 72 kilometres east from the town of George on the N2 highway, and 25 kilometres west of Plettenberg Bay on the same road.

Day 3: Plettenberg Bay

Plettenberg Bay, nicknamed Plett, is the primary town of the Bitou Local Municipality in the Western Cape Province of South Africa. It was originally named Bahia Formosa ("beautiful bay") by early Portuguese explorers and lies on South Africa's Garden Route 210 km from Port Elizabeth and about 600 km from Cape Town.

Day 3: John Benn Experience

The <u>John Benn</u> is a double-decker floating restaurant offering daily Lagoon cruises to the Knysna Heads. A memorable family activity on Knysna Lagoon. One of the best floating restaurants in Knysna.

Day 4: Mossel Bay

Mossel Bay (Afrikaans: Mosselbaai) is a harbour town of about 130,000 people on the Southern Cape (or Garden Route). Mossel Bay lies 400 kilometres east of the country's seat of parliament, Cape Town and 400 km west of Port Elizabeth, the largest city in the Eastern Cape Province.

Day 4: Botlierskop Private Game Reserve

Situated between the magnificent Outeniqua Mountains and unspoiled beaches of the Indian Ocean, in the heart of the Garden Route, lies the 4000 ha <u>Botlierskop Private Game Reserve</u> in the Western Cape ensuring its visitors of a unique South African Safari experience. Day 4: Harold Porter Botanical Gardens

We visit the <u>Harold Porter Botanical Gardens</u> at Betty's Bay, famed for its coastal fynbos (the name for the local floristic kingdom). It encompasses mountain slopes with wind-clipped heathlands, deep gorges with relict forests, flats and marshes with restios, sedges and bulbs, as well as dunes adjacent to the beach with specialised salt-adapted plants. The Garden is renowned for its waterfalls and amber pools.
